

Drupal and RiSE Integration Needs

What will transfer to RiSE on the RiSE go live:

- Most data is currently hosted in iMIS
- Data Transfer:
 - Data from job boards
 - Potentially data from organic groups (memberships, posts)
 - User Data
 - Process for data transfer:
 - Map this data to fields in RiSE, include an external ID for reference
 - Provide a sample data set; test
 - Provide a full data set; test
 - Provide a final data set for go-live
 - The data will not be removed in Drupal in case it is needed for any reason.

Drupal functionality that needs to be updated for RiSE go live:

- Block and then remove access for existing users
 - Exceptions:
 - SPN Network users
 - APGA Staff
 - Remove the ability for users to create accounts;
- Update the following Links:
 - Login/Sign up (various links):
 - Any link to the Login/sign up page should be redirected to RiSE
 - A special login page or other functionality needed for admins and SPN users
 - Discussion groups; unpublish pages; link to RiSE
 - Job boards; unpublish pages; link to RiSE
 - Join functionality; link to RiSE

Data required by Drupal (after upgraded site) from RiSE

- None of this data will required for RiSE go live.
- Garden data
 - Any Garden data required for garden look up an display
 - Location, membership, demographic, data for NPGD, etc.

Additional Notes:

- The SPN login and store remain in D6 and will be upgraded to D7
- For 2105, The National Public Gardens Day website and the APGA Annual Conference Website will not obtain any data from RiSE; they will remain separate.
- Any website content editing will be done by APGA
